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# Problem Statement


Dog owners who bring their dogs to the park encounter hostile or aggressive dogs that don't match their dog's playstyle. In addition, when planning to bring a dog to an event or into a business, it can be difficult to locate the relevant pet policy.

# Market Research



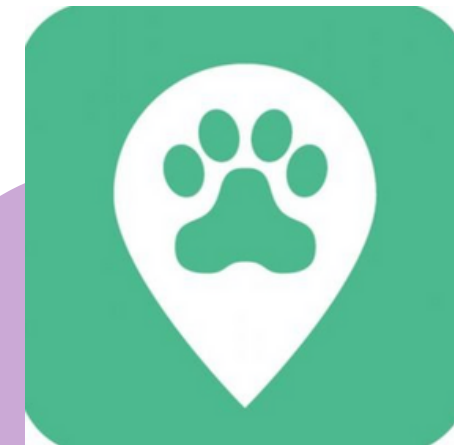
The pet industry is a valued 110 Billion dollar industry

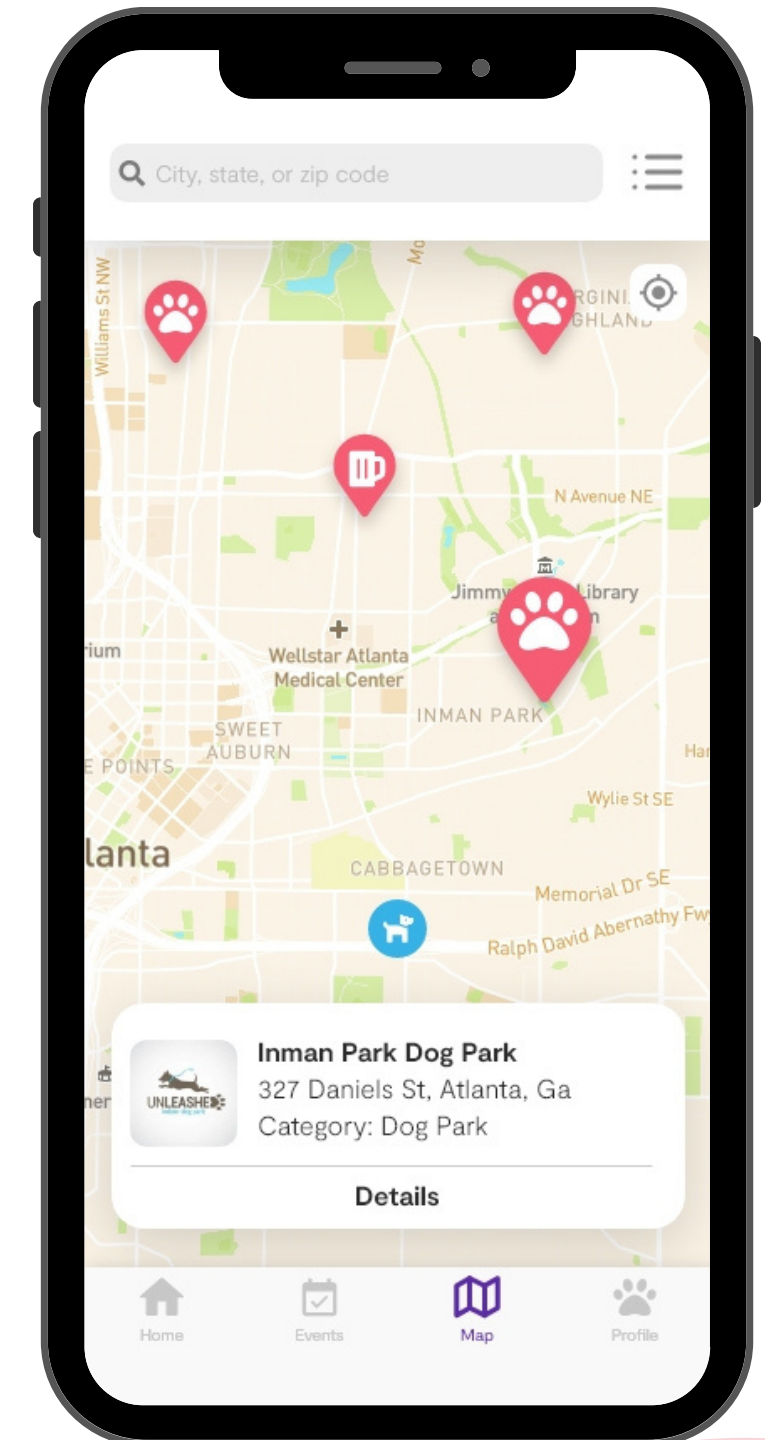
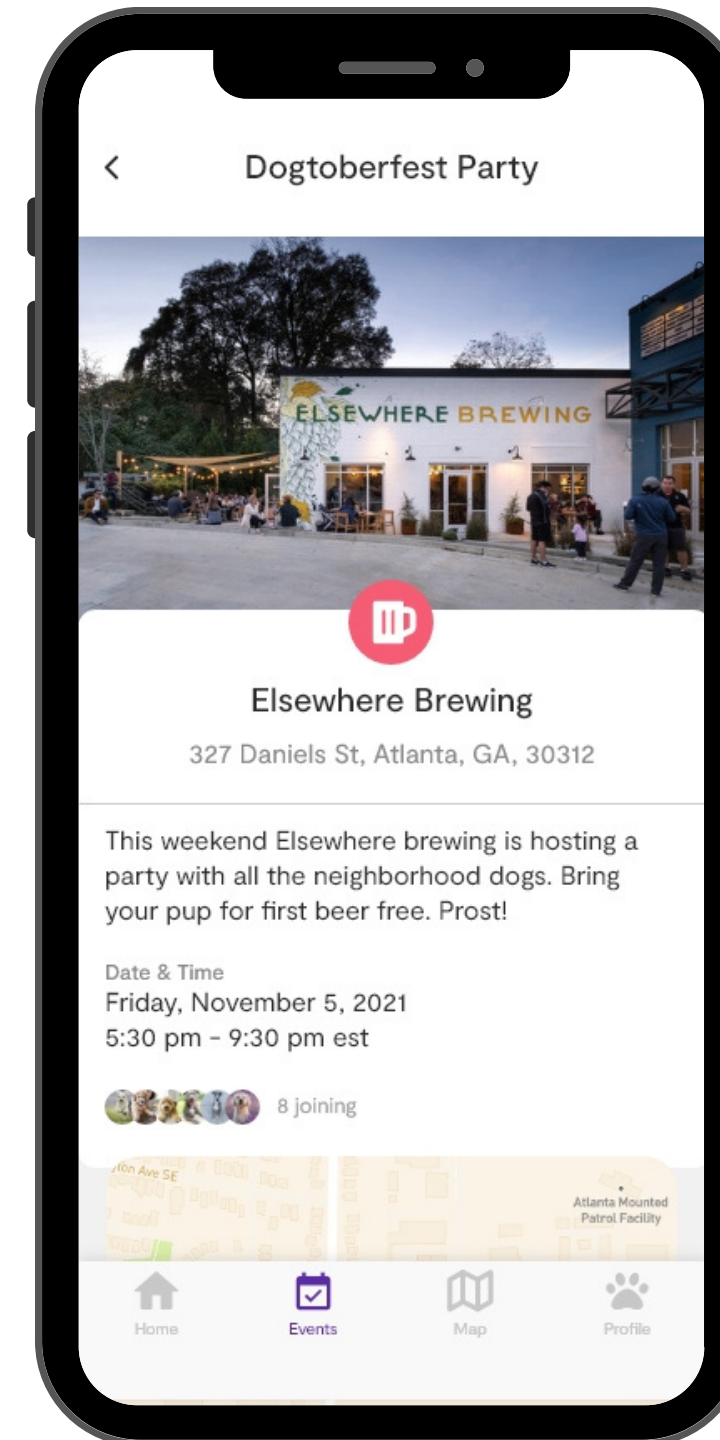
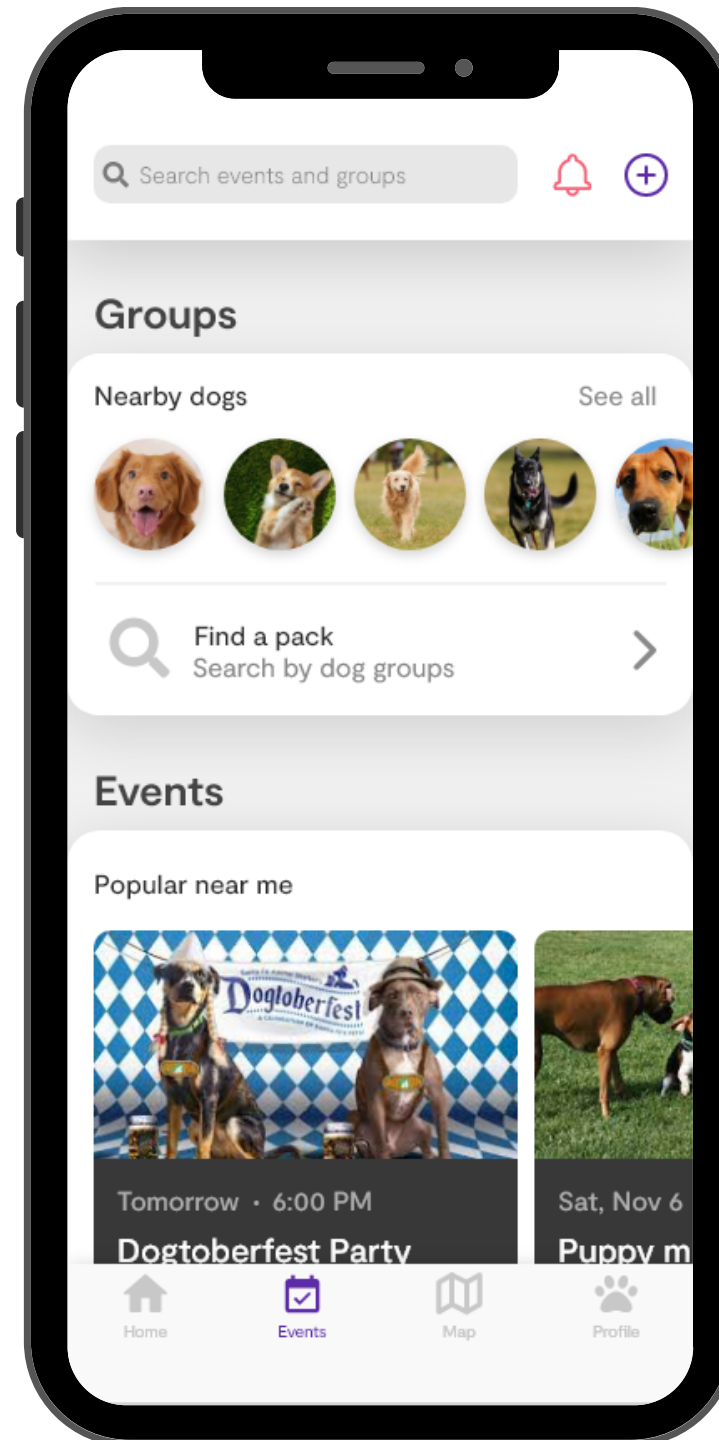
## Home

Based on this being a locally based app, we wanted to give users posting options that reflected towards a community. Posting options give users the ability to ask for recommendations like vets or businesses to visit. There are also features to report missing dogs in the area.



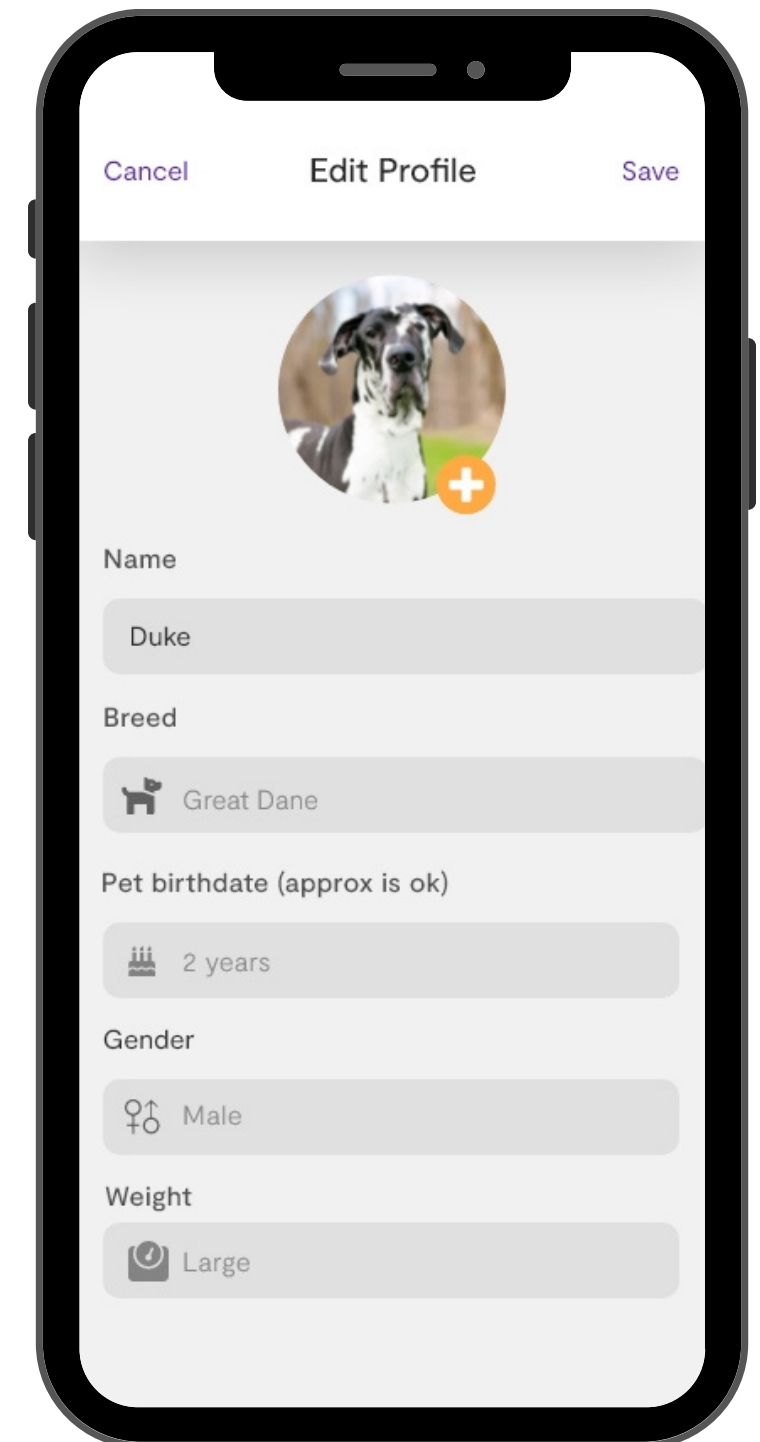
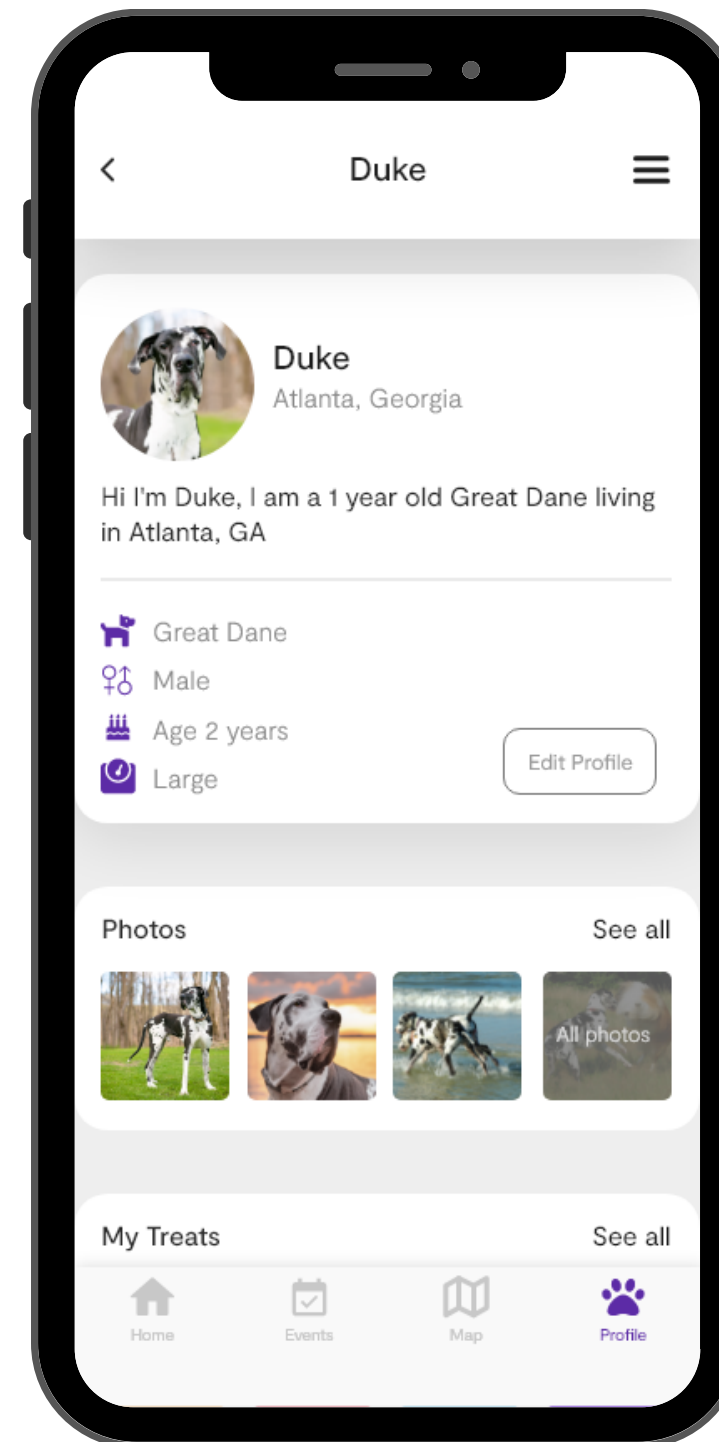
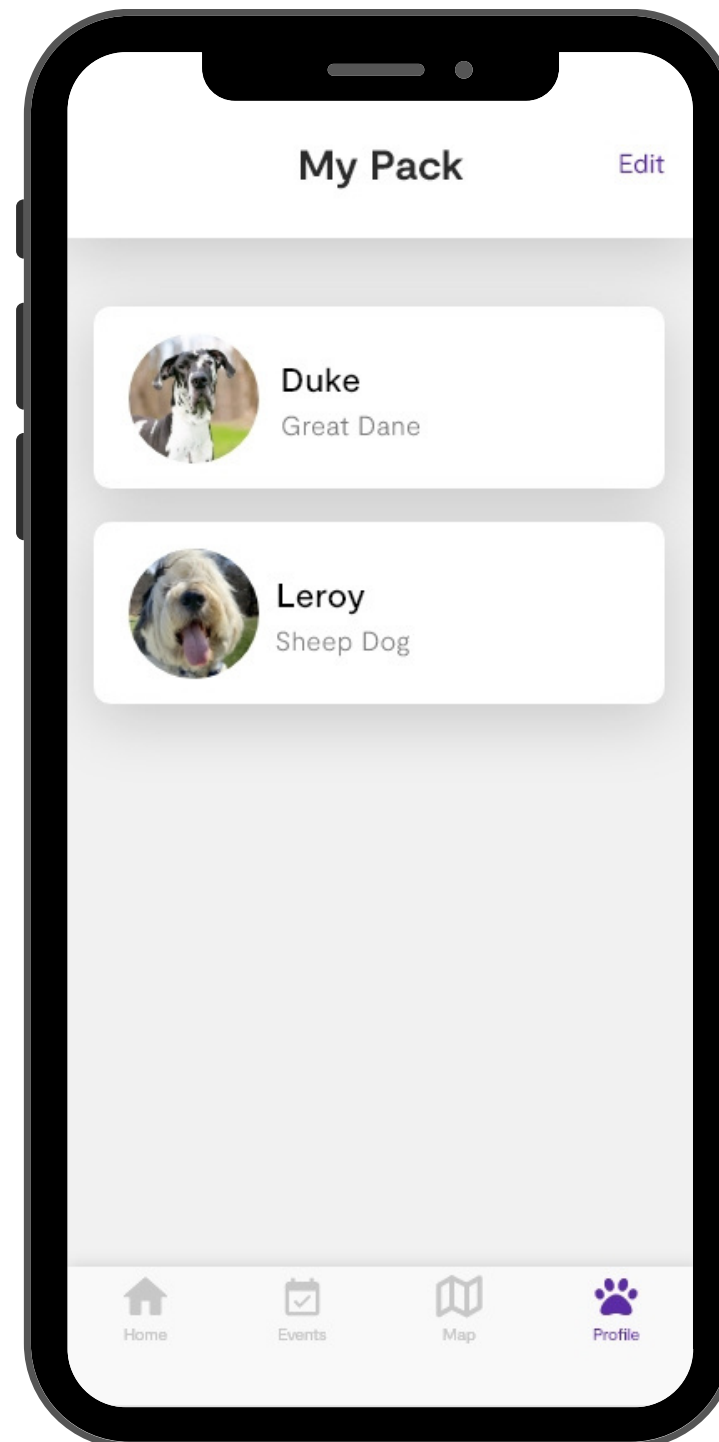
## Events

The event page gives users information on local meetup groups as well as individual meetups in your local area. There is also a map function for users to scan their local area for nearby dog-friendly businesses like breweries and dog parks.



## Profile

It is not uncommon for households to own more than 1 dog so users will be able to pick which profile they are editing. Inside the profile, they can add public photos and also view their treats (badges). These badges incentivize users to travel within their local areas.
